Note of land owned by Knapton Parish Council

April 2024

1. Allotments

The land on which the allotments are situated was gifted to Knapton Parish Council by Mrs Constance Robinson in 1965.

NB: If the Parish Council no longer needs it for allotments or similar, then it must transfer it to the church via the Rector and Churchwarden etc. or apply to the Administrators of Miss Robinson's estate to change its application.

2. The Playing Field

So called because this land was used as the Knapton School playing field and was accessed from rear of the school grounds. The Parish Council's playground is sited on it.

The land stretches from the gated entrance on Hall Lane down the side of the MADRA building (but does not include any of the building) to the first row of trees and bushes, and across to the fences of the rear gardens of the properties in School Close and Hall Lane.

This land was purchased by Knapton Parish Council for £200 from Mr David Cargill on 15th September 1955 on the understanding that it is used for recreational purposes.


NB: If the Parish Council no longer needs it for recreation, then it must apply to the Cargill family estate to change its application.

3. Wilds Way
