Norfolk Police reported that there had been 141 crimes reported this year for the area including Knapton and that last year there were 160 crimes reported, overall this is very low compared to other areas.

MOD Police Reported that they are being taken over by the Civil Nuclear Constabulary on the 1st April. They are still working closely with Norfolk Police to monitor crime in the area.

Cllr Maxfield gave his report, a copy of which can be found online. He also stated that his members budget was available for anything, highways related, that Knapton identified as a need.

Members of the public wished it to be noted that they were unhappy with the content of the minutes of the meeting held on the 5th March 2024 because they believe that they were given false information about the council not admitting that they had any MADRA documents. The public would also like it noted that they were unhappy with derogatory name calling of the residents of School Close.

A member of the public raised concern about the decision to defer the request for a Grant to St Peter's and St Paul's Church as they were struggling to be able to pay for maintenance of the Church Yard. They said that even manpower to help maintain the area would be of great help. The Clerk said that she was meeting with Restorative Justice and would see if she could get them to help out.
