

Knapton Parish Council invites all residents of Knapton to attend a

PUBLIC MEETING

Concerns have been raised by residents of School Close regarding the closure of the entrance to the development site on the Millennium field from Knapton Road and the possible consequences of heavy traffic using School Close as the alternative main site entrance.

The Chairman and Vice-Chairman of KPC met with the Site Manager and the Managing Director of Wellington, the main building contractor for the site, to raise these issues directly.

As a consequence, Wellington have produced a revised Traffic Management Plan which is designed to resolve all the issues raised and has forwarded it to the KPC for consideration.

However, the council feels that all local residents, particularly those in School Close and close by, should have the opportunity to voice their concerns and have them addressed directly by the MD of the construction company.

At the invitation of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the KPC, Mr Paul Pitcher, MD of Wellington, will be attending this meeting to answer any questions regarding this issue in order to seek an amicable solution rather than simply approaching Highways and forcing a solution which would not necessarily have the support of the residents or the Parish Council.

This meeting will close at 7.15pm and will be followed by the Knapton Parish Council meeting at 7.30pm
