CONVEYANCE

-of-

A piece of land situate at Knapton in the County of Norfolk

This conveyance is made fifteenth day of September one thousand nine hundred and fifty five between David Cargill of The Grove Gimingham in the County of Norfolk Farmer (hereinafter called the Vendor) of the one part and The Parish Council of Knapton in the County of Norfolk (hereinafter called the Council) of the other part.

WHEREAS

- 1. The Vendor is ?eised in fee simple in possession of the property hereinafter described free from incumbrances
- 2. The Council being desirous of providing a recreation ground for the said Parish have with the consent of a parish meeting held on the second day of July one thousand nine hundred fifty four signified by a resolution passed at that meeting agreed with the Vendor to purchase the said property for the purpose aforesaid under the powers conferred on it by the Local Government Acts at the price of Two hundred pounds.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:-

1. In pursuance of the said agreement and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred pounds now paid by the Council to the Vendor (the receipt whereof the Vendor hereby acknowledges) the Vendor as a Beneficial Owner hereby conveys unto the Council ALL THAT piece or parcel of land situate in the Parish of Knapton in the County of Norfolk and having a frontage of thirty three feet or thereabouts to the rod down as Hall Lane and for the purpose of identification only delineated on the plan drawn hereon and thereon coloured pink. As the same forms part of enclosure Number 155 on the Ordnance Survey Map for the said Parish TO HOLD unto the Council in fee simple subject to the observation

- and performance by the Council and its successors in title of the covenants and conditions specified in the first Schedule hereto.
- 2. The Council (with intent to benefit and protect the adjoining property of the Vendor) hereby covenants with the Vendor that the Council and its successors in title will duly observe and perform the said covenants and conditions.
- 3. The Vendor hereby acknowledges the right of the Council to production and delivery of copies of the documents specified in the Second Schedule hereto and undertakes for the safe custody thereof.
- 4. IT IS HERBY CERTIFIED that the transaction hereby effected does not form part of a larger transaction or of a series of transactions in respect of which the amount or value or the aggregate amount or value of the consideration exceeds five hundred pounds.

IN WITNESS whereof the Vendor has hereunto set his hand and seal and

two members of the said Parish Council have for and on behalf of the said Parish Council set their hands and seals the day and year before written

THE FIRST SCHEDULE above referred to

- 1. The Council shall not assign let or part with possession of the property hereby conveyed
- 2. The said property shall be used for the purpose of playing fields only and shall not at any time be used for grazing purposes
- 3. No building shall be erected thereon other than a pavilion required for such purpose
- 4. No organised games shall be permitted thereon on Sundays
- 5. The Council shall erect and for ever after maintain on the Southern and Western boundaries the land a boundary fence not less than five feet in height and made of chain-link fencing provided that such fence shall be surmounted by one strand of barbed wire one foot above the top of the fence
- 6. The Council shall not have beneficial occupation of the property but shall allow the enjoyment thereof by the public as a place of recreation under proper control and regulation and for no other

- purpose. The Council will not allow the erection of any nuisance on the said property nor allow the throwing of bottles or other objectionable material from the said property on to the adjoining land of the Vendor.
- 7. The Council will take all reasonable precautions (including so far as practicable the erection of netting) in order to prevent as far as possible the throwing of balls and other objects from the property hereby conveyed onto the adjoining land of the Vendor And will also use their best endeavours to prevent trespassing on such adjoining land.
